Please read guidance below before completing the form.

Guidance Notes:

When buying a grave, it is important to understand what the applicant is actually purchasing. There is neither the purchase of any land involved, nor is there any ownership of land transferred to the applicant. What is involved is the purchasing of **exclusive rights of burial** for a grave for a perpetual period of time. These Rights will be assigned to the **nominated deed owner** upon consideration and approval of this application form by the Council. After which a **Right-of-Burial Deed** will issue to the **Deed Owner**.

The **Deed** grants to the **Deed Owner** the right to:

- Be buried in a designated grave plot or columbarium niche, subject to space being available (includes cremated remains);
- Authorise further burials in approved grave plot(s) where space remains available, or for the interment of cremated remains;
- Apply for a **headstone permit** to seek permission to install a memorial on the grave, or on a columbarium niche, or to inscribe a memorial, or to permit an additional inscription to be added to a memorial, or to make any modifications whatsoever to a memorial; all of which shall be subject to the fees for the **Right-of-Burial Deed** having already been paid in full to the Council.

The applicant is advised to consult with Tipperary County Council's Burial Ground Bye-Laws for more detailed information.

The applicant is advised to keep the Right-of-Burial Deed safe and secure, as such is a legal document and can form part of the applicant's estate.

Please note: The Right-of-Burial Deed application form will be held by the Council in compliance with GDPR Regulation, solely for the purposes of administration of burial grounds.

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
