



## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994

### **BORRISOLEIGH TRAFFIC CALMING, BORRISOLEIGH CO TIPPERARY.**

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, as amended by Section 46 of the Public Transportation Regulation Act 2009, Tipperary County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to deliver Borrisoleigh Traffic Calming Scheme.

The proposed development includes the following key components:

- **Raised Speed Table Installation:** Located on Borrisoleigh Main Street (R498) at the junction with Templemore (R501), installation of a raised speed table with associated signage and drainage, designed to reduce traffic speeds in the area, promoting safer driving conditions.
- **Pedestrian Zebra Crossing (Type B):** Integrated into the raised speed table, the zebra crossing will provide designated safe crossing point for pedestrians.
- **Courtesy Pedestrian Crossings:** Two courtesy pedestrian crossings will be added to ensure pedestrians can safely cross at pedestrian desire lines at the junction.
- **Traffic Light Crossing Upgrades:** At the existing traffic light-controlled crossing on Borrisoleigh Main Street, installation of a raised pedestrian crossing with associated tactile paving as well as updated signage and drainage.
