

# N75 Liberty Square to Anner Hotel Road Improvement Scheme

Tipperary County Council has appointed Rathcabin Tarmac Limited to carry out a road pavement rehabilitation scheme which also incorporates safety improvement measures.

This scheme is on the N75 at Kickham Street, and extends from the junction with Cathedral Street / Mitchell Street eastwards for approximately 1200m to the 100kph gateway.

The scheme includes pavement rehabilitation/re-surfacing, replacement/widening of sections of the existing footpaths, upgrading of pedestrian crossing facilities, kerb buildouts, improved drainage, renewed road markings, signage, enhanced soft landscaping and some traffic calming

The Works will start on **July 7<sup>th</sup> 2025** and will take approximately 4 months to complete.

During this period, temporary traffic management will be required in order to ensure the construction work is carried out safely amidst live traffic.

Works of this nature will cause some disruption to residents, businesses, schools, shoppers and through traffic, but it is the Council's and the Contractor's intention to minimise this as far as possible.
