



TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT N75 LIBERTY SQUARE TO ANNER HOTEL PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

The N75 Liberty Square to Anner Hotel Thurles Pavement Improvement Scheme is scheduled to commence on 7th July 2025 with a 16-week programme to completion of the works (i.e. July to November 2025). The pavement scheme involves improvements to existing roads, footpaths, drainage, traffic calming and landscaping on the N75 at Kickham Street and Dublin Road, Thurles. The scheme commences at the junction with Mitchell Street and extends approximately 1200m to the 100kph gateway.

In order to ease traffic congestion, minimise disruption and facilitate access to premises, it is necessary to operate a one-way system on Kickham Street, Thurles from the junction with Mitchell Street to the Mill Road roundabout from July to September 2025.

Temporary Traffic Management signage, including diversion signage, will be prominently placed throughout the duration of the temporary one-way system.

The One-Way system will operate as follows:

- Westbound traffic, entering Thurles, will remain on the N75 Kickham Street and pass through the works area
- Eastbound traffic, leaving Thurles, will be diverted via Mitchell Street and Boheravoroon to re-join the N75 at Mill Road roundabout.
