



Community Climate Action Event Grant 2026

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Tipperary County Council is supporting the An Taisce National Climate Action Week which takes place from the 12th – 18th October 2025. The purpose of this funding is to support County Tipperary based **Community Groups/ Voluntary Organisations** (applicants) who wish to organise an event to coincide with National Climate Action Week. An event can be held, either during National Climate Action Week, or within the month of October 2026.
- The event proposed must focus on enhancing awareness, knowledge and/or skills within a community re Climate Action and focus on one or more of the programme themes.
- Community Groups / Organisations are eligible to apply only once.
- Applicants must be registered with the Tipperary Public Participation Network (PPN).
- Applicants must have a bank / credit union account in their own name to apply.
- Applications must be on this application form - paper copies are available on request.
- The application must be signed by the Chairperson, Secretary or Treasurer of the applicant.
- The information supplied by the applicant must be accurate and complete. Inaccurate or incomplete information may lead to disqualification and/or the repayment of any grant made.
- It is the responsibility of each applicant to ensure that it has proper procedures and policies in place, including appropriate insurance where relevant to manage the event and the grant.
- Applications must be on this application form - paper copies are available on request.
- The closing date for applications is 28th August 2026, Late applications will not be considered.
- Applications will be assessed on the basis of eligibility, Relevance to Climate Action and Value for Money
- Grant monies must be drawn down before 13th November 2026.
- **Grant monies will only be paid out on receipt of evidence that the event has taken place (attendance sheets and photographs).**
- **By submitting photographs, the applicant confirms that consent has been obtained from all individuals featured and agrees that Tipperary County Council may use the images in its publications, website, social media, and other promotional materials.**
- Evidence of expenditure, receipts /invoices must be retained should Tipperary County Council wish to inspect same at any stage.
- **Participants must register their event on the An Taisce Climate Action Week Website (link to be provided)**
- Tipperary County Council's contribution must be publicly acknowledged in all materials associated with the event.
- Breaches of the terms and conditions of the grants scheme may result in sanctions including exclusion from future grant applications. Please ensure the application form is completed in full.



- In order to process your application, it will be necessary for Tipperary County Council to collect personal data from you, such as contact information.
