5.1 Cllr. Andy Moloney; Cllr. Declan Burgess (Ref. ID 2116)

Could the District please give an update on previous motion for a cycleway from Cahir to Cashel and progress on the feasibility study stage.

5.2 Cllr. Declan Burgess (Ref. ID 2118)

That we urgently assess the Ruan-Laffina road in Clonoulty for resurfacing and strengthening works and ensure its consideration for the next road work programme.

5.3 Cllr. Declan Burgess (Ref. ID 2119)

In the interest of safety that this Municipal District considers resurfacing and re-lining Wesley Square on the Main Street in Cashel.

5.4 Cllr. Máirín McGrath (Ref. ID 2114)

That Tipperary Planning Authority would take necessary & immediate action to save the historical Knocklofty House, an 18th Century Protected Structure of architectural, artistic, historical and social significance and work with the other relevant authorities to ensure the restoration of its character.

5.5 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2117)

That this Council would provide a footpath or walk way from Longford Bridge to Cordangan in the interest of road safety for the many people that walk to town on this stretch.

5.6 Cllr. Andy Moloney (Ref. ID 2120)

That this council consider a path to link the village of New Inn with the Co-op at Outrath as it would complete a looped walk and also service people walking to the farm shop.

5.7 Cllr. Andy Moloney (Ref. ID 2121)

That historical buildings owned by NAMA and vulture funds enter into a maintenance plan with the local planning section within 3 months of their takeover.

5.8 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2133)

In conjunction with the N74 realignment at Ballyhurst, that the open drain outside the premises of Matthew and Joanne Crowe be filled in, in the interest of safety.

5.9 Cllr. Annemarie Ryan (Shiner) (Ref. ID 2135)

That this Municipal District apply for funding under the Outdoor Dining Enhancement Scheme (Part 2) for Tipperary Town. 'Part two of the Scheme relates to weatherproofing and outdoor dining infrastructure which focuses on the development of medium to large scale permanent public dining spaces in towns and centres in preparation for welcoming back visitors when it is safe to do so' Funding allocated under Part

Two will enable Local Authorities to develop permanent outdoor public dining spaces in towns and urban centres, similar to those that exist in various European cities.

5.10 Cllr. Annemarie Ryan Shiner (Ref. ID 2136)

That this Municipal District explore the provision of a separate walking/cycling lane from the where the L8215 (Cordangan) meets the N24, along the route into Tipperary town.

5.11 Cllr. Tony Black (Ref. ID 2137)

That this council install covert CCTV cameras in the laneway behind Cashel Road and Sean Allen Terrace, Tipperary town. It has become a particularly bad dumping and littering black spot. The residents are tired of dumping incidents and of incidents where dumped material has been set alight. CCTV may help catch the culprits and bring these incidents to an end.

5.12 Cllr. Tony Black (Ref. ID 2138)

That this council take away a section of the wide footpath beside 44 Glenview Square, Tipperary town in order to provide residential parking.

5.13 Cllr. Tony Black (Ref. ID 2139)

That this council will install speed ramps or traffic calming measures on Station Road, Dundrum.
