5.1 Cllr John Crosse (Ref. ID 2207)

That this Council as a matter of urgency and in the interest of safety, provide traffic calming measures at Emly School.

Speeding is an ongoing issue at this location and it is imperative that we do not wait for a tragedy to consider all options to reduce vehicle speed.

5.2 Cllr. MI FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2210)

That the open dry drain at Greenrath be filled in as some of the residents would like to improve the area and they will maintain and cut the grass in future.

5.3 Cllr. MI FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2211)

That this Council carry out immediate works to improve safety at Knockavilla NS. This is an extremely dangerous stretch of road and parents and teachers are very concerned.

The important word is unnecessarily as we are all aware of the need for certain articulated vehicles to pass through the town for deliveries or other reasons.
