4.1 Cllr. Annmarie Ryan (Shiner) (Ref. ID 2087)

That this Municipal District examine drainage infrastructure within the area known as The Plan in Tipperary Town. The green area of the Plan becomes very sodden during the wet months and may benefit from a more efficient drainage system. There is the need also for a gated frontage to be erected by the traffic lights to deter vehicles from accessing the pedestrian space. The Plan is a key recreational green space in that part of Tipperary Town and is highly valued by the community.

4.2 Cllr. Tony Black (Ref. ID 2089)

That this Council will repair and replace where necessary the footpaths on O'Connell Road in Tipperary Town. They are damaged extensively and are in serious need of repair.

4.3 Cllr Tony Black (Ref. ID 2090)

That this Council repair the broken surface on the road and around manholes on the N24 between the Pedestrian crossing on Bansha Road, Tipperary Town and the town boundary past the turn off to Longford Bridge.

4.4 Cllr. Tony Black (Ref. ID 2091)

That this Council place bins on popular walking routes throughout the Municipal District. These bins can have small openings in order to only allow in small items of rubbish and bags of dog waste. This would prevent bags of household waste being placed in them. It may also encourage people to pick up after their dogs if they don't have to carry a bag of dog foul for miles.

4.5 Cllr. Andy Moloney (Ref. ID 2099)

That this Council request an update on the progress of the Waterford to Limerick junction rail line following last year's meeting with Barry Kenny.

4.6 Cllr. Andy Moloney (Ref. ID 2101)

That this Council erect a driver feedback sign on the Ardfinnan Road in Cahir as a means to slow down traffic approaching a busy play school and sports grounds.

4.7 Cllr. Roger Kennedy (Ref. ID 2102)

That the roadside drain which took water from the front of Dan O Reilly house at Chartersland, Emly be reopened before his house gets flooded.

4.8 Cllr. Roger Kennedy (Ref. ID 2103)

That Tipperary County Council examine the dangerous bend in Latin Village and take remedial action to make it safe.

4.9 Cllr. Marie Murphy; Cllr Micheál Anglim (Ref. ID 2104)

That this Council would install 'speed cushions' on the approach to St. Mary's National School, Clogheen. The speed of traffic passing the school is dangerous despite the speed limit and the 'driver feedback signs' which were installed about 4 years ago and have proven not capable of preventing some motorist from speeding.
