5.1 Cllr. Roger Kennedy (Ref. ID 2153)

That the members be given an update on the OPW efforts to secure a site for an interpretive centre and admission centre for Carraig Phadraig.

5.2 Cllr. Micheál Anglim (Ref. ID 2154)

I call on the council to build a footpath in the interests of pedestrian safety from Ros Na Grèine Estate Ardfinnan to Castle View estate Ardfinnan. In doing so it would connect Ros Na Grèine Estate with the footpath going through the village.

5.3 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2161)

That the green area behind Fr. Mathew Court, be cleaned up and that CCTV be provided, in association with the residents who are willing to play their parts in keeping it tidy.

5.4 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2162)

That this Council make every effort to examine road safety at Monard NS, which is the only school situated on the N24 in our county. There are serious issues regarding road safety to motorists, parents, children and teachers. It is necessary to provide a school warden at school times to marshal the zebra crossing. We also need to look at what works can be carried out on the Cullen Road approaching the school from that side to improve parking. This is a matter of great concern in the area and I enclose a petition from concerned parents and residents who are most anxious that this Council do everything in its power to help.

5.5 Cllr. Roger Kennedy (Ref. ID 2163)

That the members be given an update on any efforts attempted to ensure the implementation of the existing agreed rules and regulations pertaining to St Cormac's Cemetary, Cashel.

5.6 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2164)

That the road at Farnamanagh be strongly considered to be resurfaced in next years programme as there are now many families living in this area.

5.7 Cllr. Micheál Anglim (Ref. ID 2168)

I call on the Council to build a footpath connecting Castlevew Estate Ardfinnan to Mount Carmel Ardfinnan. It is a small stretch of the village that has no footpath at present.

I call on the Council to put in place a pedestrian crossing with a ramp at the top of Mount Carmel as you enter St Finnan's Estate Ardfinnan. It is a busy pedestrian area with both adults and young children crossing the road to the shop.

5.9 Cllr. Declan Burgess (Ref. ID 2172)

That this Municipal District engages with the relevant stakeholders in identifying suitable locations for the installation of electric car charging points across the district, such as places like Dundrum and Bansha.

That this Council engage with the owners of the BOI site in Cashel and consider entering into an agreement to use the site as a remote working hub for our community.
