5.1 Cllr. Andy Moloney (Ref.ID 2232)

That horses on road signs be erected on the Ardfinnan Road in Cahir at Lisakyke and Grangemore, on approach to the Swiss Cottage entrance, due to the large numbers of horses using the woods and fisherman's path.

5.2 Cllr. Micheál Anglim (Ref. ID 2239)

I call on the Council to replace the footpath in St Anne's Terrace Ardfinnan as soon as possible.

5.3 Cllr. Anne Marie Ryan (Shiner) (Ref ID 2242)

That this Municipal District review the existing Bye- Laws for the regulation and control of the consumption of intoxicating liquor in public spaces and arising from this review, the District adopts a zero tolerance policy to consuming intoxicating liquor in a public place and to non compliance when directed to leave immediately in an orderly manner. Furthermore, this Municipal District collaborate closely with the Gardai to proactively prohibit on-street drinking and begging in public places, which is causing distress to members of the public who have a right to peacefully enjoy their public spaces without feeling intimidated.

5.4 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2247)

That immediate steps be taken to carry out immediate measures at the Steeples Estate, Cashel. The residents are extremely concerned regarding the speeding of vehicles in the Estate.

5.5 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2248)

That this Municipal District request the Department of Environment to prioritise a Wastewater Treatment Plant for Golden Village. It would promote Industry and further development and improve the many attractions of the River Suir, from a local tourism point of view at this historic location.

5.6 Cllr. Michael FitzGerald (Ref. ID 2249)

As the largest Municipal District in County Tipperary, that we request extra funding to bring many of our rural roads up to a decent standard before the winter sets in, and all public lighting be checked prior to the evenings and mornings getting darker.

That this District upgrade the pedestrian crossing on Main Street, Tipperary Town. The markings are fading, it should be better lit and it is not well signposted. There have been a number of near misses in recent months and this District should take steps to ensure all measures are taken to prevent any future problems.

That this District will place a sign on Main Street, Tipperary Town to notify motorists of the pedestrian crossing on Church Street. Motorists approaching from Main Street often take the bend too quickly and are on top of the crossing before they realise it is there. There have been accidents on this crossing before and countless near misses. A sign on Main Street between James Street and O'Brien Street would be an ideal

location.

I am urging Tipperary County Council to submit a new Rural Regeneration Development Fund (RRDF) application for the Cashel Town Park Development and the necessary public realm upgrades at the earliest and next round of the RRDF Category 1.
