Election of Cathaoirleach The Cathaoirleach spoke of his experience in the past year as chair of the Carrick-on-Suir Municipal District Members. He said that the first six months had been a bedding in process, and that the District system was working well. Highlights during the year included the achievements in relation to the Bus Service, the sod turning for the new school in Carrick-on-Suir, the Contract for the Carrick-on-Suir to Clonmel Greenway, the reception for the Canadian Ambassador in August 2014 and the civic reception for Eoin Kelly in Mullinahone earlier this year.

He concluded by thanking members and staff for their co-operation over the year.

Cllr. David Dunne proposed that the d'Haut system be used to select a Cathaoirleach, and proposed that Cllr. Imelda Goldsboro be elected as Cathaoirleach. Cllr. Imelda Goldsboro declined the nomination.

Cllr. John Fahey proposed that Cllr. Eddie O'Meara be elected as Cathaoirleach, and this was seconded by Cllr. Louise McLoughlin. As there were no other nominations Cllr. Eddie O'Meara was declared elected, and retook the chair.

Addressing the meeting, The Cathaoirleach thanked his proposer and seconder and the members for the honour that had been bestowed on him. The main issues to be addressed in the coming year included

- The supporting of business in Carrick-on-Suir
- The renewal of the villages in the district
- Maintenance of County and Tertiary Roads
- A House Building Programme for Carrick-on-Suir
- Bringing local Government to the people

The members joined in congratulating the Cathaoirleach, as did the Director of Services and the District Administrator.

Election of Leas Cathaoirleach

The Cathaoirleach called for nominations for Leas Cathaoirleach.

Cllr. Kieran Bourke was proposed by Cllr. Imelda Goldsboro , seconded by Cllr. David Dunne.

As there were no other nominations, Cllr. Kieran Bourke was declared elected.
