Minutes of Meetings On the proposal of Cllr. John Fahey, seconded by Cllr. David Dunne, the minutes of the monthly meeting held on the 24th of November, 2016 were adopted and signed by the Cathaoirleach.

Cllr. David Dunne asked whether the finalised report on the flooding incident in January 2016 had been received. The District Administrator responded that the report had not been finalised as yet, but would be put before the members as soon as available.

Update from Director for Community and Economic Development Ms Julia Walsh, Outreach Officer at the County Museum gave a report on the activities at the museum. Main points included the completion of the assessment for the Museums Standards programme, and the request by the County Museum to the Nation Museum of Ireland to display artefacts found during road construction in Tipperary, and the hoard of coins found in Carrick-on-Suir.

Ms Fiona Crotty gave a presentation on the activities of the directorate in relation to Carrick-on-Suir.

Cllr. David Dunne welcomed the request that the Carrick-on-Suir Coin

Hoard be displayed in the County Museum, and asked if the hoard could be displayed in Ormond Castle.

Cllr. Kieran Bourke also supported the display of the Coin Hoard in the County Museum.
