(a) Councillor Marie Murphy

That under the 2016 Roadworks programme, the Borough District would put measures in place to slow down traffic on the Clogheen road approach to Ballyporeen.

(b) Councillor Marie Murphy

That under the 2016 Roadworks programme Clonmel Borough district would replace the footpaths between Wyse's Garage, Clogheen and St Mary's School as the current footpath is in a deplorable condition.

That under the 2016 Roadworks programme, Clonmel Borough District would as a matter of urgency, take measures to alleviate the serious issue of flooding at Ballinahalla, Clogheen.
