Speaking of her coming term of office, she alluded to the challenges facing the councillors, particularly in maintaining the roads network in the district following extreme weather with the resources available. The Cathaoirleach finished by welcoming the opening of the new primary care centre in Carrick-on-Suir, which will provide a full range of primary health services and give a huge boost to Carrick-on-Suir and its area.


