Mr. P. Fee circulated the draft Multi-Annual Restoration Improvement Programme. He felt that it was an improved programme and discussed the changes that were made to the previous programme. He informed the members that if they were not happy with the programme they could revert to the original one.

Cllr. M. O Meara requested that the Redwood Road to Redwood Castle would be moved to year one and the Old Birr Road (Kylenamuck) be moved down to year three.

Cllr. McGrath, Darcy and Ryan mentioned the road at Killowney Little, Ballymackey. Mr. P. Fee informed them that this road is not on the programme.

Cllr. J. Carroll requested that a list of roads that have a rating below 4 would be circulated to the members.

The issue with the bog roads was also raised and Mr. M. O Connor suggested that the members should meet with Oireachtas members to discuss the issue.

The Multi-Annual Road Improvement Programme 2019-2021 with the change of moving the Redwood Road to Redwood Castle to year 1 and the Old Birr Road (Kylenamuck) to year 3 was proposed by Cllr. J. Carroll and seconded by Cllr. M. O Meara.

Members proposed that a meeting should be arranged with Minister Shane Ross if this is possible.
