Each Bursary covers a two-week stay at the Tyrone Guthrie Centre at Annaghmakerrig, Co. Monaghan. Facilities at the centre include artist studios, music room, dark room, acoustic recording studio and performance/dance space. There is also wheelchair accessible accommodation as well as the possibility of an artist being accompanied by a carer. The successful artist will agree the dates and required space directly with the Tyrone Guthrie Centre.
