6. **Consideration of the following notices of motion:-**

(a) Councillor Andy Moloney

Cahir is on the Motorcycle Tour of Ireland Trail. Can we have a designated motorcycle parking bay in Cahir to cater for this trail and be included on the bikers guide as part of the Trail.

(b) Councillor Andy Moloney

That this council provide a cycle lane between cahir town and the ABP factory due to the large numbers of people cycling to work at the facility.

(c) Councillor Andy Moloney

That this Council provide electronic " Slow down " signs at either side of the crossroads at Poulmucka as its a blind cross and in bad need of extra signage.

(d) Councillor Martin Lonergan and Councillor Richie Molloy

That Clonmel Borough District would consider providing a raised pedestrian crossing with appropriate signage on the R665 in the vicinity of the entrance to Gleann na Súire, Ardfinnan which would greatly add to the safety of pedestrians and also curb excessive speeding.

(e) Councillor Pat English

That Clonmel Borough District Council provide traffic calming measures (speed ramp and signage) in Morton Street, to curtail the cars that speed through this road.

(f) Councillor Siobhán Ambrose

That Clonmel Borough District Council engages with representatives from the South Tipperary Autism Group in both providing them with a suitable site and helping them to source the relevant funding for a sensory garden in Clonmel.

(g) Councillor Siobhán Ambrose

That Clonmel Borough District Council investigates both the reason for the series of accidents on the N76 at Seskin in Kilsheelan and in turn source the necessary funding to rectify the problem.

(h) Councillor Siobhán Ambrose

That in the interest of safety that this Council investigates the possibility installing the special speed limits at Rathkeevan School on the N24 similar to those installed at Poulacapple School on the N76 and in conjunction investigate improving the high grassed entrance to the school off the N76.

(i) Councillor Martin Lonergan

That Clonmel Borough District would replace the footpath on the R665/Clogheen Road exiting Ballyporeen and extend it to service the remaining two houses.

(j) Councillor Pat English

That Clonmel Borough District Council clear the existing car track to the rear of houses no. 83 to 97 Barron Park, Clonmel.

(k) Councillor Pat English

The Clonmel Borough District following on from the redevelopment of Denis Burke Park and the new green way from the Convent Bridge to the dog track, and the introduction of the canoe slalom below Lady Blessington's Bath, develop the lower section of Suir Island for the use of the public, with a pedestrian link from Sarsfield Street onto the Island, and then connecting with Denis Burke Park.
