Mr. Ladden will be involved in dealing with Taking in Charge of estates. Cllr. M. O'Meara welcomed the report and welcomed the proposed development of the Centre of Excellence. He commended Planning on watching for funding opportunities. He raised the issue of the problems with the North West Regional Water Supply Scheme and the fact that it could lead to difficulties with people getting Planning Permission. Cllr. H. McGrath also welcomed the update on the Centre of Excellence and requested that consideration would be given to improving the use of the lanes and the pedestrian crossing at

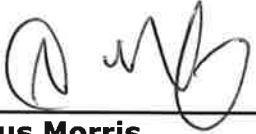
